Withdrawal of Three Corrective Measures Evaluations and Suggested Priorities for New Mexico Environment Department Review of Documents

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA) has submitted a number of documents to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) for review pursuant to the 2005 Consent Order and the environmental cleanup at the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). In accordance with Section VI.B of the 2016 Compliance Order on Consent (Reference 1), these documents would normally continue through NMED-HWB review. However, EM-LA would like to formally withdraw three corrective measures evaluations (CME) from consideration:

- Corrective Measures Evaluation Report for Material Disposal Area G, Solid Waste Management Unit 54-013(b)-99, at Technical Area 54, Revision 3 (LA-UR-11-4910) submitted to NMED on September 9, 2011;
- Corrective Measures Evaluation Report for Material Disposal Area H, Solid Waste Management Unit 54-004, at Technical Area 54, revision 1 (LA-UR-11-5079) submitted to NMED on September 9, 2011; and
- Corrective Measures Evaluation Report for Material Disposal Area L, Solid Waste Management Unit 54-006, at Technical Area 54, Revision 2 (LA-UR-11-4798) submitted to NMED on September 9, 2011.

EM-LA has developed its life-cycle cost estimate and nominal schedule for the work remaining under the 2016 Compliance Order on Consent (Reference 1) and determined that the time frame required for other DOE work scope that drives the availability of Material Disposal Areas (MDA) G, H, and L for the execution of any potential remedy is too long and that it is not reasonable for EM-LA to request that NMED-HWB continue the review of the current documents. EM-LA will therefore complete its other DOE work scope in TA-54, evaluate the effects of completion of this other work scope on the MDAs (if any), evaluate any newly available remediation technologies, and conduct and submit new CME reports incorporating all the newly available information in

conjunction with the applicable campaign listed in Appendix C of the 2016 Consent Order (Reference 1). This should allow NMED-HWB to make a decision on 'fresh' information instead of 'dated' information.

With the above withdrawals, EM-LA requests that NMED-HWB complete the review of the only remaining CME at the NMED-HWB for review, *Corrective Measures Evaluation Report for Material Disposal Area C, Solid Waste Management Unit 50-009 at Technical Area 50*, (LA-UR-12-24944) submitted to NMED on September 28, 2012.

In addition, EM-LA would like to offer its priorities for the NMED-HWB review of the remaining LANL documents already submitted and falling under Section VI.B of the 2016 Consent Order. Enclosure 1 summarizes suggested priorities for NMED-HWB reviews. Enclosure 1 reflects the discussion of priorities that EM-LA had in a meeting held with NMED-HWB on July 15, 2016 and identifies the campaign as identified in the 2016 Consent Order Appendix C affiliated with the work scope. EM-LA recognizes that a significant number of documents are currently at the NMED-HWB for review and that the NMED-HWB target review timeframes of Appendix D of the Consent Order are not going to be achievable. In accordance with Section XXIII.D of the Consent Order, EM-LA requests that NMED-HWB meet to determine when they plan on completing the review.

With the issuance of the 2016 Compliance Order on Consent, documents considered to have a specific submittal date to NMED-HWB under the 2005 Consent Order do not have a specific submittal date under the 2016 Consent Order (Sections II.A and VIII). These documents are still necessary, but the work will be executed under the 2016 Consent Order campaigns listed in Appendix C. Enclosure 2 lists the documents that have been previously identified under the 2005 Consent Order and ties the work to the applicable campaigns in the 2016 Consent Order Appendix C.
